- Your child has to come to school regularly and on time.
- Materials which the pupils need to learn must be brought by them every day. In the beginning you will receive a timetable and the material list your child needs.
- Homework assignments help children to repeat the important contents of classroom instruction and you as parents can help them by asking for and on it. Please do make sure that the children do all their homework exercises.
- If your child is ill, call the school (02251/6505655) and tell the name of your child and its class briefly. If your child is ill longer than 2 days, please go to a doctor with your child and ask for a statement (date and time of presence) to give as an excuse to the school.
- The most important committee of our school is the 'Schulpflegschaft' which represents the parents and organizes the content of education at school. It is consists of representatives of each class. If you like to get in contact with the representatives Mrs Geppert und Mr Jacobs call the office or write an email (see homepage) to our school and we'll organize a contact.
- On 25th of September 2014 a friends' association was founded. This association supports our school in many ways. All parents are asked for support. If you are interested please contact the chairwoman Mrs Klinkenberg by email.
- The comprehensive school is a school for all children and enables all school graduation levels. The pupils stay together until the 10th class but they are increasingly visiting main subjects in different courses with individual levels.
